

LIST OF GOVERNMENT SCHOLARSHIPS

The following Scholarships are available. Interested students can apply directly-

1. Name of Scholarship: PM-USP Central Sector Scholarship Scheme for College and University Students

Deadline:

1. Date for inviting scholarship applications: 31.10.2025
2. Institute Level Verification: 15.11.2025
3. SNO Level Verification: 30.11.2025

Eligibility: Students who are above 80th percentile of successful candidates in the relevant stream from the respective Board of Examination in Class XII of 10+2 pattern or equivalent; Students with gross parental/family income upto Rs. 4.5 lakh per annum are eligible for scholarship under the scheme.

Amount: The rate of scholarship is Rs.12,000/-per annum at Graduation level for first three years of College and University courses and Rs.20,000/-per annum at Post- Graduation level.

2. Name of Scholarship: Post Metric Scholarship for Minority Students

ELIGIBILITY:

- * Scholarship will be awarded to the students who have secured not less than 50% marks or equivalent grade in the previous final examination
- * the annual income of whose parents/guardians from all sources does not exceed Rs.2.00 lakh.

Amount: Admission and tuition fee for UG & PG level: Rs. 3,000/- per annum subject to actuals (both Hosteller & Day Scholar)

3. Name of Scholarship: Innovation in Science Pursuit for Inspired Research (INSPIRE)

Eligibility: Meritorious Students with aggregate marks within top 1% of their Class XII examination of any State/ Central Education Board in India are eligible. In addition, the student must be pursuing courses in Natural and Basic Sciences at the B.Sc., B.S., B.Sc. with Research (4 years) and Int.M.Sc./M.S. level.

Amount: Each candidate will receive annual scholarship @ Rs. 5000/- per month with total value of Rs. 60,000/-. All the SHE scholars are required to undertake summer research projects under an active researcher in any recognized research centre across India. A summer time Mentorship grant

of Rs.20,000/- will be paid every year. The scholars have to submit the Project Report and Certificate from Mentor after the completion of the project in due course of time.

4. Name of Scholarship: CM Higher Education Scholarship

Eligibility –

Students who are natives of Rajasthan, passed their 12th examination with at least 60% marks, are within the top one lakh of the merit list, have an annual family income of up to ₹2,50,000/-, and are not receiving any other scholarship.

Benefits-

Eligible students receive 500Rs per month for up to 10 months, totaling 5,000 annually. Students with disabilities receive 1,000 per month for up to 10 months, totaling 10,000 annually.

The scholarship is available for a maximum of 5 years for regular students in higher educational institutions.

5. Name of Scholarship: Labour or Job Card Scholarship – Nirman Shramik Siksha Kaushal Vikas Yojana in Rajasthan

This scheme is launched by the Government of Rajasthan to provide financial assistance for education and skill development to the children of registered construction workers in the state. Under the scheme, scholarships for education will be provided to the workers' children.

Eligibility –

The daughter, son, or wife of a construction worker will be eligible to avail benefits under the scheme.

Benefits-

Meritorious students from class 8 to postgraduate level will be given cash awards ranging from Rs 4000/- to Rs 35,000/-.

6. Name of Scholarship : Rajasthan Kali Bai Bheel Medhavi Chhatra Scooty Yojana

Eligibility –

- Girl students who have passed Class 12th:
Minimum 65% marks in Rajasthan Board of Secondary Education (RBSE).
Minimum 75% marks in Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE).
- Must be pursuing a graduation degree in Rajasthan

- Must be a regular student (not enrolled in distance learning).
- Students with annual family income less than 2.5 lakh

Benefits-

- Scooty distribution to girl students for academic excellence.
- A lump sum amount of 40,000/ for students who previously received a scooty under another Rajasthan state government scheme based on Class 10 results.

How to Apply

1. Click on sso.rajasthan.gov.in website.
2. Login with your SSO ID.
3. After login, select "Scholarship" application.
4. After this click on (CE, TAD, Minority) option.
5. Now the form of Kalibai Bhil Medhavi Chhatra Scooty Yojana will open in front of you.
6. Select "Student" option in the form.
7. Fill all the required information carefully.
8. After filling the information, check it once again.
9. If all the information is found correct, click on the submit button.

7. Name of Scholarship- Reliance Foundation Scholarships

Scholarships for UG for all streams

Deadline : 15th October 2025

Eligibility: Passed Standard 12th with minimum 60%, currently enrolled in the 1st year (academic year 2025-26) in a regular full-time degree course in any stream. Students having House Hold income <Rs. 15 Lakhs (preference given to <Rs. 2.5 Lakhs). Aptitude Test is mandatory

Amount: The total amount of scholarship available over the duration of the degree programme, will be up to Rs/INR 2 Lakh

8. Name of scholarship: Azim Premji Scholarship

Deadline: 15 Oct, 2025

Eligibility: Candidate must have passed 10th and 12th as a regular student and has taken admission in the first year.

9. Pradhan Mantri Uchchatar Shiksha Protsahan (PM-USP) Central Sector Scheme

Scholarships for UG/PG for all streams

Deadline: October 31, 2025

Eligibility:

The applicant must be above the 80th percentile of successful candidates in the relevant stream from the respective Board of Examination in Class 12th of 10+2 pattern or equivalent. The gross parental/family income of the applicant should not exceed ₹4,50,000/- per annum. The students are required to have Aadhaar seeded bank accounts opened in their name.

Amount

- 12,000/-per annum at the Graduation level for the first three years of College and University courses.
- 20,000 per annum at the Post-graduation level.
- 20,000/-per annum in the 4th and 5th year to the Students pursuing professional courses, in case, where the duration of the course is five (5) years/Integrated course.

Name of Portal- *National Scholarship Portal*

Eligibility: Indian nationality, a minimum passing score in the previous exam (often 50% or more), and a family income within the specified limit for the particular scholarship. Applicants must also meet other criteria like age limits, academic levels (e.g., class 11 to higher education, post-secondary courses), and specific community or category requirements depending on the scheme.

- OTR is required to apply for scholarship on National Scholarship Portal.
- One Time Registration (OTR) is a unique 14-digit number issued based on the Aadhaar/Aadhaar Enrolment ID (EID) and is applicable for the entire academic career of the student.
