

A visit to slum area of Kotra Village was organized by Arthniti, the Economic Club and Forum under the aegis of Sophia Girls College Ajmer on 15<sup>th</sup> August 2017. It feels strange that a place just a few kilometers away from the main city seems like a different zone for existence. This makes me aware of what disparity actually is and how lucky I'm, was astonishing.

A handful of students went to the slum area of Kotra Village with some fruits, clothes and first aid kits for distributing among slum dwellers. Sights such as dirty stagnant water, clogged drain, narrow lanes, cramped houses and heaps of garbage welcomed us. Seeing us the residents gathered all around telling us about their grievances.

Just a few hours in slum area made us feel heavy. Imagine people spending their whole lives in slums. Slum development needs to work on a better level; our government has to work on ground level development. It's up to people like us to help the poor and voice their lament.
