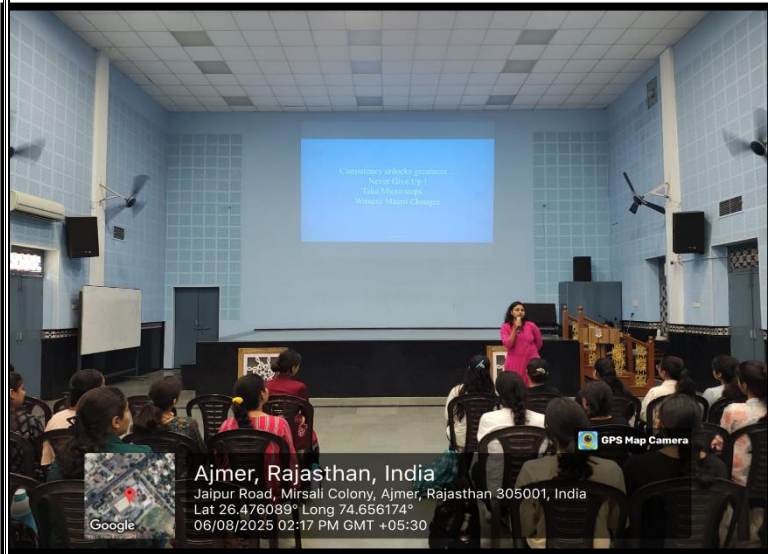
Name of the Activity: Career Counselling Event

Date: 06th August 2025

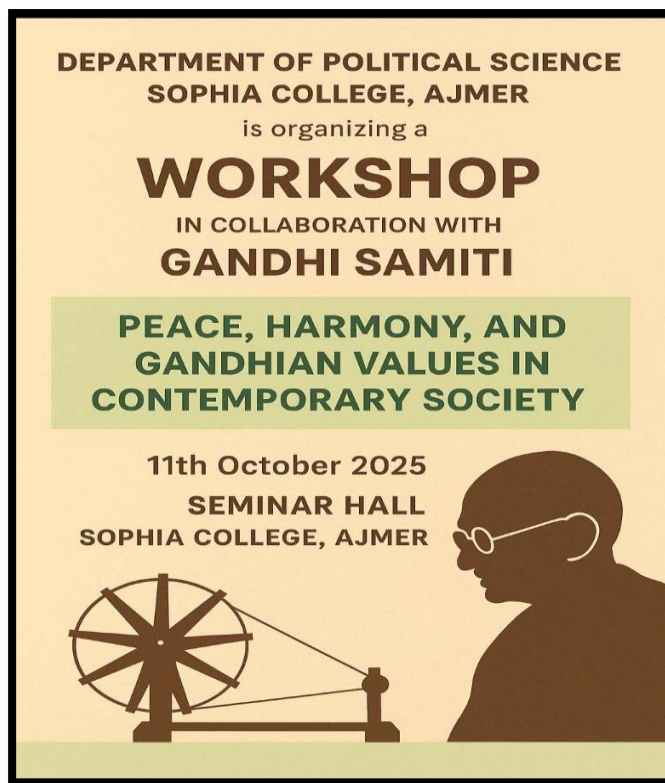
No. of Students (Attended the event) – 40

No. of Students (Attended the event) – 105

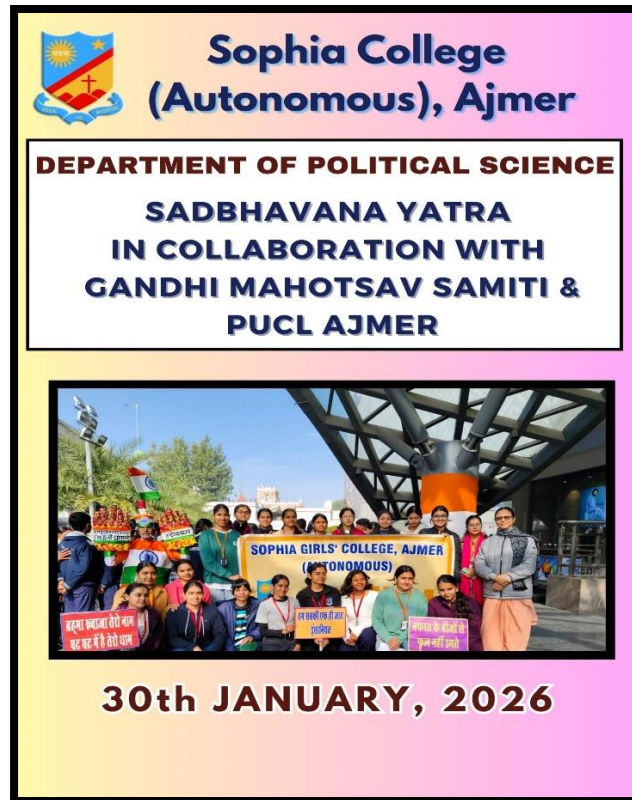
