**Date:** 26<sup>th</sup> October 2024

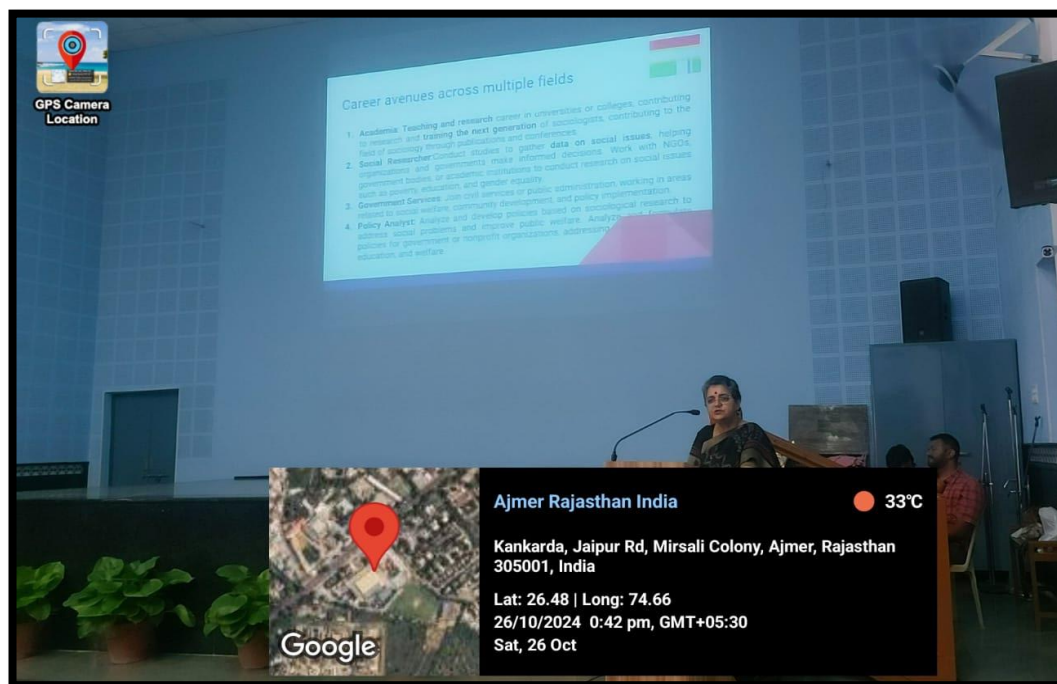
**Venue:** Room no.: 30 (Auditorium)

### **Industrial Visit to Greentech Mega Food Park, Rupangarh**

#### **Objectives of the visit:**

To understand the working of a food processing park and its socio- economic significance

To gain knowledge about supply chain management in the food industry

To explore opportunities for entrepreneurship in food processing sector

A group of students from Sophia Girls' College (Autonomous), Ajmer's Economics and Sociology Department went on an educational field trip to Rupangarh, Rajasthan's Greentech Mega Food Park on 29 March 2025. The purpose of the visit was to give students direct knowledge of the food processing sector, its effects on the economy, and its contribution to rural development. Greentech Mega Food Park is a cutting-edge facility created to boost agricultural value chains and assist food processing companies.
