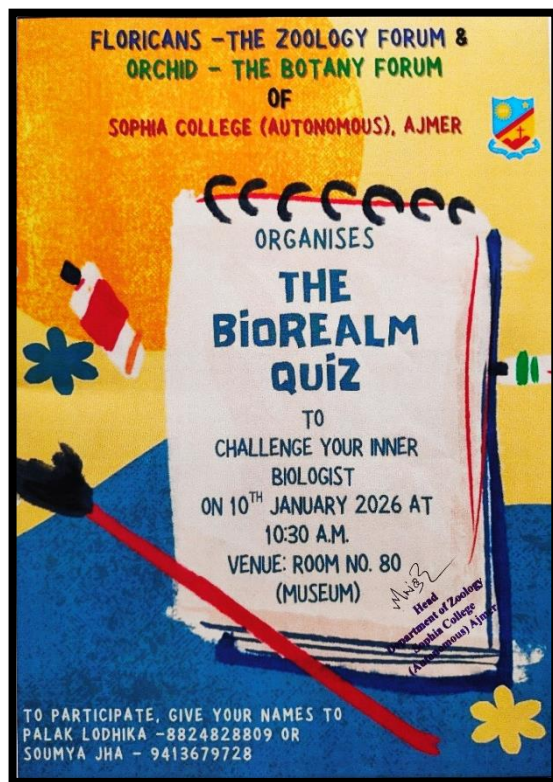

Objective of the Activity –

The objective of the visit to Nahargarh Biological Park was to introduce the students with practical exposure to wildlife conservation and biodiversity and help them understand the diversity of fauna and flora, their natural habitats, and behavioural adaptations in a semi-natural environment.

Report:

On 21st August 2025, 41 students of B.Sc Biology visited the Nahargarh Biological Park where they learnt about the endangered species, conservation strategies, and the importance of protected areas in maintaining ecological balance. Through direct observation, students related the theoretical concepts of ecology, zoology, and environmental studies with real-life examples, thereby enhancing experiential learning, environmental sensitivity, and interest in wildlife research and conservation.

Objective of the Activity –

The objective of celebrating Wildlife Week in College was to create awareness among students about the importance of wildlife conservation and biodiversity protection and to develop sensitivity towards endangered species and environmental issues. Report:

Objective of the Activity –

The objective of conducting the Bird Walk on the World Wetlands Day was to enhance the knowledge about the Avian Fauna in the surroundings amongst the students. It also helps to understand the need to conserve their habitat and how are we responsible for destructing their natural habitat.

Report:

The students of Nature Club and Floricans of Sophia College (Autonomous), Ajmer along with Maharshi Dayanand Saraswati University and Forest Department of Ajmer, on 2nd February 2026, participated in a Bird Walk on World Wetlands Day to create awareness about the food and habitat of the native and migratory birds and the need to conserve the areas that the Avian fauna inhabit. The trail also helped the students to identify various birds along with their characteristics.

विश्व वेटलैंड दिवस पर विद्यार्थियों ने किया नेचर वॉक
'वेटलैंड जैव विविधता का महत्वपूर्ण आधार, इन्हें बचाना जरूरी'

अजमेर @ पत्रिका विश्व वेटलैंड दिवस पर मंगलवार को यहाँ दयानंद सरस्वती विश्वविद्यालय के इको क्लब, पर्यावरण विज्ञान विभाग, सॉफिया कॉलेज और वन विभाग के संयुक्त तत्वावधान में आनासमारा किनारे बर्ड वॉक का आयोजन किया गया। इसके तहत वेटलैंड पारिस्थितिकी तंत्र, पक्षी और जैव विविधता के प्रति जागरूकता बढ़ाई गई। विद्यार्थियों, शिक्षकों और वनकर्मीयों ने 80 प्रतिभागियों के स्थानीय एवं प्रवासी पक्षियों को देखा। पक्षियों के भोजन व्यवहार, प्रजनन आदतों, प्रवास चक्र और उनके प्राकृतिक आवास के बारे में जानकारी दी गई।

परीक्षित डॉ. विवेक शर्मा ने बताया कि पक्षी पर्यावरण स्वास्थ्य के संवेदनशील संकेतक होते हैं। उनकी संख्या में बदलाव पारिस्थितिक असंतुलन का संकेत देता है। इस दौरान प्रतिभागियों ने 3 किलोमीटर की यात्रा की। सॉफिया कॉलेज की जुलैजी विभाग शिक्षक डॉ. मुगाका उपाध्याय ने बताया कि वेटलैंड जैव विविधता का महत्वपूर्ण आधार होती है। यह देशी और प्रवासी पक्षियों के लिए सुरक्षित आवास के साथ-साथ भोजन पुनर्भरण, बाढ़ नियंत्रण, जल शुद्धिकरण और जलवायु संतुलन में भी सहायक होते हैं। प्रतिभागियों ने वेटलैंड के संरक्षण, प्लास्टिक प्रदूषण कम करने और प्राकृतिक जल स्रोतों को स्वच्छ रखने का संकल्प लिया। इस दौरान महर्षि दयानंद सरस्वती विश्वविद्यालय के रॉनक चौधरी, निवेदिता शर्मा सहित वन विभाग के क्षेत्रीय वन अधिकारी जय सिंह चौधरी, सहायक वनपाल नीमा देवी, करू चौधरी, महेश श्रवास्तव, खेली, वनरक्षक बच्चराज सिंह, शर्मिला, उमोद राम, निंबाराम गोदारा एवं चंद्रप्रकाश मौजूद रहे।
